

Topic: Creation – God’s Majesty Seen on the Earth

Note: The practical applications provided in the lesson are offered as suggestions to help the saints in their preparation. They are not meant to direct or limit the ways in which the focus of the lesson can be applied. The saints are encouraged to pray and contact the Lord to receive His burden and guidance in teaching and applying the lesson. Fellowship with other saints, and inquiring of the children themselves, may also bring out many helpful applications.

Elementary:

Verse: “...What is sweeter than honey, And what is stronger than a lion?” (Judges 14:18).

Focus: Creation shows us God’s majesty. God created many different animals. The animals can manifest God’s majesty and splendor.

Practical Application: God did not create just one kind of animal—He created numerous kinds of animals. What is your favorite animal? God created some animals to be cute and personal. God created others to be powerful and impressive. Consider the lion, the eagle and the horse. The lion embodies power and mightiness. The eagle is considered dignified and graceful. The horse is strong and sleek. These animals demonstrate different aspects of grandeur and beauty, and show that their Creator, God, must be majestic.

Intermediate:

Verse: “Consider well the lilies of the field...not even Solomon in all his glory was clothed like one of these” (Matthew 6:28-29).

Focus: Creation shows us God’s majesty. God created so many plants and trees on the earth. These plants and trees manifest God’s majesty and splendor.

Practical Application: God created many types of plants and trees. What are some that you know? Consider the giant redwood tree. It is majestic in its size. The redwoods are some of the largest and tallest trees in the world. They can grow to over 400 feet. How impressive it is to gaze up at the height of a redwood tree! Consider the different types of flowering plants with all their beautiful colors. It is estimated that there are more than 300,000 species of flowering plants. A meadow of flowers is a beautiful sight to behold. God created all the plants and trees on the earth to declare His majesty and splendor. Bring pictures of flowers and trees with different colors, shapes, and other characteristics.

Advanced:

Verse: “You are Jehovah, You alone; You have made heaven, The heaven of heavens with all its host, The earth and all that is on it, The seas and all that is in them; And You give life to all of them; And the host of heaven worships You” (Nehemiah 9:6).

Focus: Creation shows us God’s majesty. God created the earth with land and water for many living things to exist. Both the land and the water created by God express His majesty. No creation of man can match the beauty and splendor in God’s creation.

Practical Application: Although land covers only about 30% of the Earth, yet it is home to millions of species of life, and supports a population of over 7 billion people. The land includes majestic mountains, the tallest of which is Mount Everest at over 29,000 feet high. The rest of the earth is covered by water. Have you ever sailed on the ocean and considered how vast it is? If we consider the beauty, wonder, richness of life, grandeur, and vastness of the earth with the land and the water, it is truly awe-inspiring to realize that God created all these things. Surely creation declares God’s majesty. Could man ever create such things?
